The year 2018-19 began with planning and plethora of activities. Adding another feather in the illustrious cap of KCT's Krishna School, it became the pioneer school of Senior Secondary Level affiliated to CBSE at Karad. The school began its 1st batch of Grade 11 with 17 students on roll, making the total tally of 1071 students. The Year 2018-19 continued its legacy of achieving 100 % result for Grade 10 (AISSE) for the 3rd consecutive year. 70% of students secured distinction.

We aim to facilitate experiential learning by enabling the students to participate in various theme based activities and celebrations such as Colour days, Season days, Krishna Janmashtami, Bendur, Nagpanchmi, Dusshera, Diwali, Christmas, Traditional Day, English Day etc. To support and motivate the talents of every child many competitions like Fancy Dress, Chart making, Skit competition, Drawing competition, Math Quiz competition, Solo Singing and Patriotic group dance competitions were conducted. We also conduct value based assemblies in which a purposeful attempt is made to inculcate the moral values amongst the students. The seniors and senoritas who completed their kindergarten experienced ecstasy in receiving their certificates on the convocation day.

Arnav Patil from Prep Sr and Miss Saee Ingawale of grade 3 have completed 48 hrs continuous skating and made an entry in the Guiness Book of World Records. She also bagged the second place in District level skating competition at Satara.

Master Mourya Jadhav from Grade 4 bagged the first place in District level Skating competition and he is the proud recipient of Central Government's Major Dhyan Chand National Sports Award for outstanding performance in skating.

While setting the goals of **Secondary School**, we believe that real education does not restrict itself in the boundaries of only prizes and graduation but it sees beyond it; benefiting a learner from concrete education.

To enhance the academic skills students appear for various competitive exams. To mention a few examinations like the Olympiads, Scholarship Exams for Grade 6 and Grade 8, Bhaskaracharya Mathematical Talent Search Exam, NTSE- that is National Talent Search Examinations etc are conducted. Students from Grade 1 to 10 appear for these exams earning medals for themselves and the school.

In the IEO Examination 18 students bagged School Level Gold, 10 students bagged School Level Silver and 9 students bagged School Level Bronze medals. Karape Shounak Rajeshkumar of grade 3, Sawant Neha Umesh of Grade 9 and Mane Sujit Suryabhan of Grade 10 have qualified for Level 2- IEO Examination.

In the NSO Examination 11 students bagged School Level Gold, 3 students bagged School Level Silver and 3 students bagged School Level Bronze medals. Shaikh Mohd Tallah of grade 8 and Kumbhar Ojas Shekhar of Grade 10 have qualified for Level 2- NSO Examination.

In the IMO Examination 8 students bagged School Level Gold, 8 students bagged School Level Silver and 8 students bagged School Level Bronze medals. Sikchi Mokshada Satwarup of Grade 3, Mane Arti Prashant of Grade 4, Patil Harshit Subhash of Grade 5, Mehtre Isha Sunil of Grade 6, Pawar Shourya Sanjay of Grade 7 and Gurav Chaitanya Shriram of Grade 8 have qualified for Level-2.

In the GK Olympiad Examination 11 students bagged School Level Gold, 3 students bagged School Level Silver and 3 students bagged School Level Bronze medals.

Sairujula Anupam Kolekar of Grade 9 cleared the 1st level of Dr Homi Bhaba Bal Vaigyanik Spardha and has been qualified for level 2. Aleena Jamir Inamdar of Grade 9 bagged the Gold Medal In the IOS examination organized by Silver Zone Foundation, New Delhi in association with **NASA**.

It was indeed a proud moment when Abhishek Tanaji Mali of Grade 10 was awarded the "Dr A.P.J Abdul Kalam Outstanding Student of the Year" Award by Himakshara Foundation. He is the founder of a Youtube channel AASC having over 12k subscribers and over 2.5 million followers. He is selected by Google Community USA, in the Google Developers Community for his outstanding work in Artificial Intelligence. Even the CBSE has now taken the initiative in introducing the subject Artificial Intelligence in the curriculum of grade 8, 9 and 10 from the next academic year.

Khabale Rajveer Arvind of Grade 2 has bagged AK Level 1st rank and Champion of Champions Trophy National Level Abacus Exam held at Bangalore. Rutuja Vijay Shah of Grade 6 bagged the Second Place in the Akhil Bhartiya Sangeet Exam. Sapkal Avadhut Mahesh And Sapkal Atharva Mahesh of grade 8 won the Bhagwad Geeta Competition and were awarded with a bicycle as the first prize. Shivankar Rainak of Grade 9 also won the same competition earning a trophy for himself.
